Title-summaries are needed to assist the Scientific Program Planning Committee with determining a conference program as well as to initiate the process for publishing papers from the conference. The deadline for online submission of title-summaries of title-summaries is 1 February 2016.

Please note that at least one author of each paper presented at the 13th ITRC must be a member in good standing of the International Turfgrass Society. An author cannot be the sole member on more than one paper submission.

Journal Options for Publishing. The ITS Board approved new publishing options for the 2017 ITRC at the 2015 mid-term Board meeting. Papers at the 2017 ITRC will be published in one of three peer-reviewed journals based on subject matter and successful review: *International Turfgrass Research Journal* (ITSRJ), *Crop Science* or *Agronomy Journal*. Please review the standards of each journal (see URLs listed below) to determine the appropriate selection for your paper.

Please note that the standards for *Crop Science* and the *Agronomy Journal* are more rigorous than the *ITSRJ* but also realize that both *Crop Science* and the *Agronomy Journal* have an impact factor whereas the *ITSRJ* does not. Additionally, if a paper submitted to *Crop Science* or *Agronomy Journal* is not accepted, authors may have it considered for publication in the *ITSRJ*.

Page charges to authors will be as low as \$0 for articles that do not exceed the page length specific to the journal. Charges for the *ITSRJ* will be \$0 for 5 pages plus \$100 per page for 6+ pages. Charges for *Crop Science* will be \$0 for 7 pages plus \$50 per page for 8+ pages. And charges for *Agronomy Journal* will be \$0 for 7 pages plus \$100 per page for 8+ pages for ASA members or \$200 per page for 8+ pages for non-members of ASA. All papers published in the *ITSRJ*, *Crop Science* and *Agronomy Journal* will be included on an electronic (flash drive) proceedings provided to delegates at the conference. The electronic proceedings will also be available through members-only section of the ITS website.

Re-announcing the Graduate Student Competition at the 2017 ITRC

The ITRC will host a graduate student competition for both oral and poster presentations. Students can submit manuscripts for consideration as an oral or poster presentation under any of the following categories: 1) Pest management strategies, 2) Turfgrass physiology and soil health, 3) Genetics and breeding, and 4) Environmental aspects of turfgrass management. Contestants will be judged on the innovativeness of their research goals, the

robustness of their scientific methods, and the delivery of their oral presentation or appearance of their poster. Modest cash prizes and a complimentary ITS membership will be made available to the top three contestants in each category. Only one submission per student is allowed, and contestants must be enrolled as an active graduate student at the time of the meeting to be eligible for the competition.

Fall 2015 Annual Meeting of JSTS and IZS held in Naha City, Okinawa, Japan

The Japanese Society of Turfgrass Science (JSTS) held their 2015 fall annual meeting and International Zoysiagrass Symposium (IZS) in Naha City, Okinawa, Japan on November 20-23 at the Okinawa Jichi Kaikan. Okinawa is the southernmost prefecture and is a humid subtropical island with a yearly average temperature of above 20 C (68 F). Most of us enjoyed the warm, welcoming weather during the visit.

On the first day of the meeting, the attendees either joined JSTS's technical tour or played golf. The technical tour group visited Koganenomori field, Shurei Country Club, and Okinawa Cellular Stadium. At Shurei Country Club, we observed the well maintained bentgrass greens. The golfing group went to Okinawa Country Club, The Southern Links Golf Club, Palm Hills Golf Resort, or Naha Golf Club to play.

The fall annual meeting of the JSTS was held on the second day. During the morning; golf course, ground cover plants, school turf, and parks and open spaces' sectional meetings were held. In the afternoon, the symposium with the various topics related to turfgrass in Okinawa were presented.

The IZS meeting was held on the third day. Dr. Don Loch, Dr. Joon Soo Choi, Dr. Liebao Han, and Mr. Makoto Kobayashi gave presentations about

At the speech contest, Dr. Tanaka won first place presenting analysis of genetic diversity and morphological traits of Zoysia spp. In Japan, Ms. Okazaki and Dr. Hayakawa were also presented awards. At the discussion section, future research on zoysiagrass was discussed.

On the last day, the attendees chose IZS's technical tour or to play golf. The technical tour visited Ocean Expo Park and Cape Manzamo. Cape Manzamo is a national park and is the native habitat for Zoysiagrasses. The golf group played at Ocean Castle Country Club or Kise Country Club. The next JSTS meeting will be held at the University of Chiba from May 27th to 29th in 2016.

In Memorial of Prof. Dr. Werner Skirde

After serious illness Prof. Dr. Werner Skirde, honorary member of The Landscape Development Society (FLL), passed away on 30 November 2015, aged 86 years. As a committed scientist, he advanced the green industry, especially the landscaping and vegetation technology, preceded by pioneering work. His broad and in-depth knowledge he passed on not only to his many undergraduate and graduate students, but to all interested professionals of the profession. His application-oriented research and teaching extended to a broad range of topics in horticulture, landscaping and sports field construction, among other things, with a focus on turfgrass, biodiversity for erosion control, tree plantings, vegetation bearing layers, waste recycling, reclamation and nutrient dynamics.

After graduation and training for agronomist, Werner Skirde earned a doctorated in 1958 as an assistant at the institute for Agronomy of the University of Rostock. He then moved to the Justus Liebig University (JLU) Gießen, The Institute for Grassland Management.

As early as 1967 he organized there the first Research Centre in Germany and directed the Experimental Station Großen Linden. From 1968 on, he brought over decades across his expertise and scientific knowledge prevail in the standardization

work to DIN 18035-2 to 4 (sports fields) and DIN 18917-18920 {Vegetation technology in landscaping}. For 40 years he also advised the German Football Federation (DFB) on the subject of football turf, where he headed the working group of the grass sports ground Construction Committee and was instrumental in the preparation of the compendium Construction and Maintenance of Sports fields.

In 1970 Werner Skirde took over together with P. Boeker the publication of the magazine Lawn-Turf-Gazon and initiated in 1975, the working group Vegetation technology, sports and leisure facilities, from which in 1979 the Support Society of Landscape- and Sportsfield construction Research Giessen eV {FLSF} emerged. The FLSF promoted directly and efficiently to carry out tests, experiments and research projects and supported institutionally until 1994 applied research of the Department of Landscaping at the Institute of Soil Science and Soil Conservation of JLU Giessen.

Since 1968 more than 35 years the annual International Turfgrass Kolloquia took place in several European countries, with large professional encouragement. The last one was organized in Denmark in 2004. It was later followed up by the foundation of the European Turfgrass Society (ETS).

In 1979 Dr. Werner Skirde was the impetus for carrying out a policy and evaluation of suitability tests on pre-finished soil mixtures for sports turf surfaces {REBR} to develop and publish. In the same year he took over together with H. J. Liesecke at the Patzer publishing company the series "Technologie of Landscaping and Vegetation" and brought out volumes 1 and 2,"Technologie in Vegetation - Turf and Hydroseeding" as well as "Maintenance of Sportsturf".

In March 1980 Dr. Werner Skirde was appointed professor for landscape development - landscaping - Vegetation technology at Justus Liebig University Giessen and was co-founder of the field of the study program "Environment assurance and Rural Development", the oldest environmental program at a

German university.

Until his retirement in 1994 his research and work mainly focused on the following areas.

- Equipment, supply and ecology of landscaping permanent crops (extensive and sometimes longterm field trials in areas intensive turf / sports turf, mixing, levels of care, rooting trials, extensive turf, extreme surface greening), bioengineering, and improving the structure of soils and interaction soil/plant.
- Biodiversity for recreation areas with local wildflowers seed and special planting methods.
- Planning. Construction and maintenance of golf courses (publication of the guideline for construction of golf courses in the FLL 1990, extended version 2000).
- Organic additives and soil improvement vegetation-rootzones. Nutrient output and nitrate problems as well as characterization of fertilizers.

The results of the research have been published in many journals and especially 1978-1990 in the "Journal of Technology in Vegetation, Landscaping and Sportsfield construction".

During his time as a professor at the Justus-Liebig-University Giessen Prof. Dr. Werner Skirde was in charge of more than 60 undergraduates and 5 Ph.D.'s. From 1965 to 1994 more than 200 technical papers and 12 journals were authored by him. But even after that he stayed in this profession as an expert and consultant for a long time, as an author and valuable discussion partner.

Prof. Dr. Werner Skirde engaged professional and private life intensively for our profession and has made an enormous contribution to it.
